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Teacher Manual available in new languages

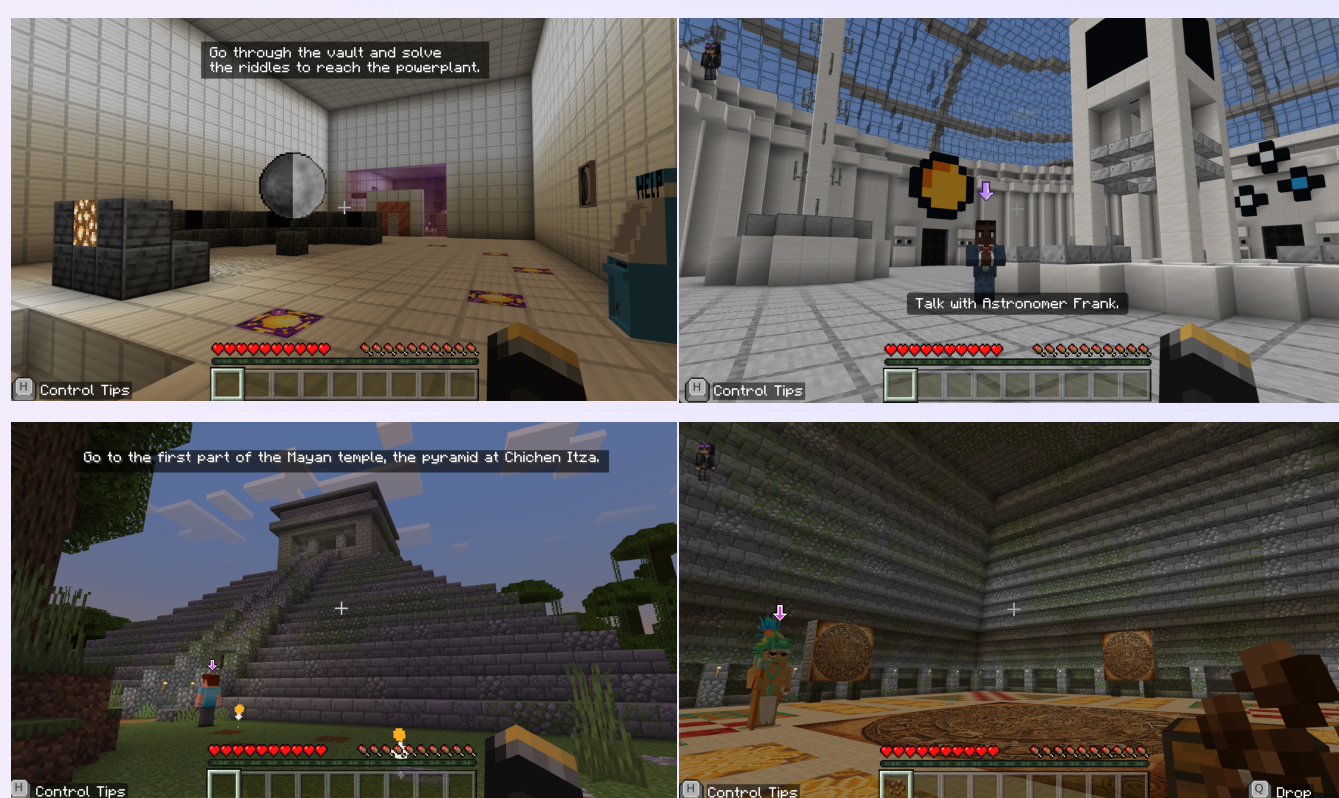
The Astronomine Teacher Manual is now translated into the languages of the partnership!
